High School Lesson Plan - After The Faire

While you visit The Lady of the Lakes Renaissance Faire, you will be immersed in a re-creation of a 17th century village, having the opportunity to hear "first hand" about the role of politics in England from the townspeople and possibly King James I himself. Afterwards, you will showcase your experiences and knowledge gained during your visit.

For your project, you will be the author of a small local newspaper with an emphasis on politics in the early 1600's.

Using an 11" \times 17" piece of cardboard (folded in half "hamburger style") as your base, you will be write, edit, organize and display a newspaper fit for King James himself!

In your newspaper, you must include the following:

- 1. Title for the newspaper.
- 2. One **major headline** with 150 word featured news story to appear on the front page with at least one picture (photo or drawing).
- 3. Two **minor news stories** of 75 to 100 words to appear on inside pages of the newspaper with at least one picture each (photo or drawing).
- 4. An **Editorial column** with at least two dissenting opinions about any topic relevant to this time.
- 5. Advertisements for three products or services to barter or buy with pictures (photo or drawing).
- 6. One **small article** (50 to 75 words) describing a local form of entertainment with one picture or drawing.
- 7. A weather report including a map drawing.
- 8. One obituary; picture of deceased optional.
